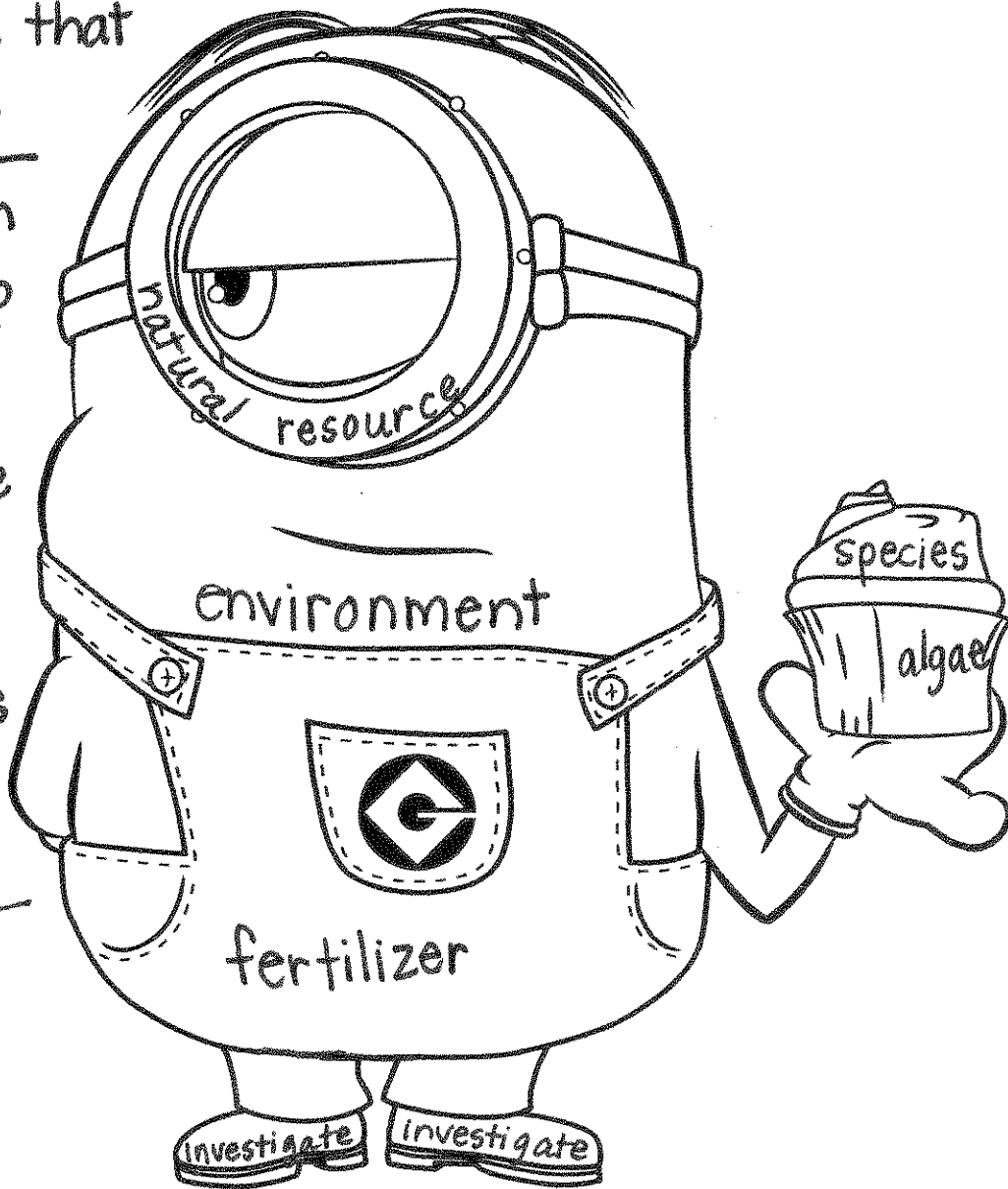

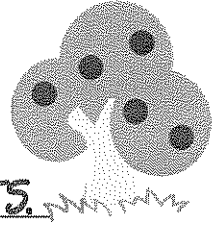


Plant Resources

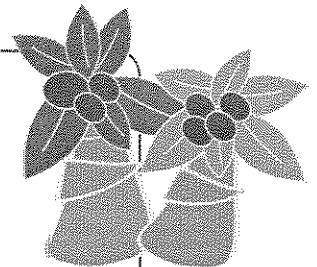
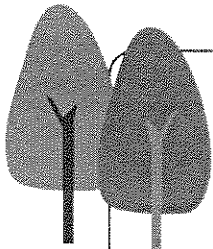

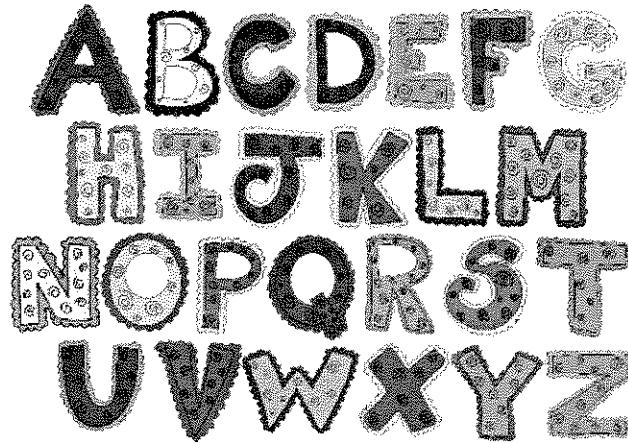
Flamingo Migration

Flamingos are social animals that migrate for several reasons. First, flamingos will migrate if they start to feel too crowded. If they feel crowded, they will migrate to a new place that has more space. Second, flamingos will migrate if they start to run out of food. When this happens, they will look for a home where more food is available. Finally, flamingos will migrate if their home becomes too noisy. For example, flamingos dislike airplane noise, so they will migrate to get away from it. When flamingos migrate, they are doing it for a good reason.
